Just a few notes for sectionals.

The sectionals have started, the first round is complete and we are now into the quarter round. Beginning with the quarter round, three-man crews will be working the games. As everyone knows by now there will be no cross-boarding this year until the semi-final and the final rounds. I suggest that the officials assigned the sectional games and working the three-man crews take a few minutes and review the IAABO Manual on a crew of three. Remember all officials are to work IAABO high school mechanics. Most of the crews will, more than likely, have a college official working on the crew who will have experience in working three-man.

It is very important to conduct a good pregame. Be sure to be at the game site in plenty of time to allow you the time for the pregame. Talk about switches and be careful of double whistles. Good eye contact and good signals will help keep you out of trouble. Remember, stop the clock first with your arm raised straight up, with a closed fist for a foul and an open hand for a violation. "No blarges" Maintain good concentration, exhibit a professional image at all times and you will have a good game.
